3. Product appearance	Green coloured, knot free, wedge shaped timber of varying widths between 75mm & 300mm. Weathers to silver-grey.
4. Product composition	Cedarwood impregnated with ammoniacal copper quarternary liquid. Impregnation residuals as copper didecyldimethylammonium chloride.
5. Intended uses	Pitched roofing.
6. Odour	Pleasant cedarwood aroma.

Exposure Limits:	
CHRONIC EFFECTS	
Standard Inhalation: Health Hazards	Overexposure is unlikely.

First Aid	Exposure to volatile organic compounds when timber is burnt. Remove patient to fresh air. Lay patient down. Keep warm and rested.
